

Homework and Home Learning at St Mark's CE Primary School

Please find below the current expectations for homework across the school.

We aim to follow these guidelines as closely as possible but there may be some occasions when changes will be made at the year group's discretion. Please contact your child's teacher if you have any queries.

Reception

- Reading - daily
- Sound book and word lotto – weekly
- Magic maths – approx fortnightly (spring term onwards)
- Handwriting/number formation mat sent home at the beginning of the year

Year 1

- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- English reading-related task/magic maths(20 minutes) – alternate weeks
- Spellings – weekly
- Occasional informal topic learning

Year 2

- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- Maths (25 minutes) alternate weeks with English reading-related task - occasionally topic or science
- Spellings – weekly

Year 3

- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- English reading task/maths – alternate weeks
- Spellings – weekly
- Topic-based activity (science/history etc) as and when appropriate

Year 4

- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- English reading-related task – weekly
- Spellings – weekly
- Maths – weekly (35 minutes)
- Topic-based activity (science/history etc) as and when appropriate

Year 5

- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- English reading-related task – weekly
- Spellings – weekly
- Numeracy – weekly (40 minutes)
- Topic-based activity (science/history etc) – as and when appropriate

Year 6

- Spellings – weekly
- Reading – daily (minimum 4x per week – signed by adult)
- English reading-related task – weekly
- Maths – weekly (60 minutes)
- Topic-based activity (science/history etc) – as and when appropriate
