**YEAR 4 – STONEHENGE TRIP – THURSDAY 23 OCTOBER 2025**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we will be taking a trip to Stonehenge on **Thursday 23 October 2025** as part of our Prehistoric Ages topic in History!

We will be travelling to Stonehenge by coach as a whole year group. Whilst we are there, the children will have the chance to explore the historic site, as well as take part in various teacher led activities related to the learning the children will be doing in class. The coach will be departing school at 8:50am so please ensure you arrive to school promptly. We will be leaving Stonehenge at 3:00pm with the aim of arriving back to school by 4:30pm (traffic dependent).

Children will be required to wear school uniform on the trip, although they may want to wear trainers or other suitable footwear in case they get dirty. Please ensure your child has warm clothing and a rain coat as we will be outside all day and the weather may be unpredictable. The children are requested **not** to bring money as we will not be visiting the gift shop.

The children need to bring a bag with a packed lunch, full water bottle and a waterproof coat. If your child has booked a hot school meal for that day, a packed lunch will be provided for them. Should you wish to provide a packed lunch from home, please contact the office to cancel this before **Tuesday 14 October 2025**.

We request a voluntary contribution for the trip and the guidance for this visit is **£25.00 per child**. We are dependent on the voluntary contributions for the visit to go ahead and ask parents to help with this. However, it is important to point out that, we may have no choice but to cancel the visit if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel and fees.
