Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to be taking Year 2 children on an exciting trip to Beaulieu Motor Museum where they will enrich their understanding of transport through the ages.

The children will be travelling by coach. We will be leaving school at **08:45** and aim to return back to school for **15:30**. Please can you ensure your child is in school promptly on this morning.

The children will need to wear their PE kit including comfortable trainers. They will need a wet weather coat/sun hat and be sun creamed at home – weather depending.

Please provide your child with a named packed lunchbox and at least two named drinks (no cans or glass bottles), in a suitable backpack. If you have already ordered a hot lunch for your child, then your order will automatically be converted to a packed sandwich lunch. However, if you wish to provide your own packed lunch for this trip, **please make sure you cancel your hot meal order for that day with the school office Before Friday 5 June 2026 at the latest.** The school frequently incurs losses by preparing lunchboxes, which are not taken up on trips.

For this trip, we request a voluntary contribution of a minimum of **£25.20 payable through Arbor before Wednesday 27 May 2026**. We are dependent on the voluntary contributions for the visit to go ahead and ask parents to kindly support with this. We will have no choice but to cancel the visit if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel and fees.
