YEAR 4 – STONEHENGE TRIP

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we will be taking a trip to Stonehenge on **Thursday 15 October 2026** as part of our Prehistoric Ages topic in History!

We will be travelling to Stonehenge by coach as a whole year group. Whilst we are there, the children will have the chance to explore the historic site, as well as take part in various teacher led activities related to the learning the children will be doing in class. The coach will be departing school at 8:50am so please ensure you arrive to school promptly. We will be leaving Stonehenge at 2:15pm with the aim of arriving back to school approximately **3:35pm** (traffic dependent).

Any booked lunches will be provided as school packed lunches, otherwise please provide a packed lunch from home as usual. If you normally have a booked lunch but will be providing your own packed lunch, please cancel your hot school dinner on Arbor before **Tuesday 6 October**. You will also need to provide drinks.

Children will be required to wear school uniform on the trip, although they may want to wear trainers or other suitable footwear in case they get dirty. Please ensure your child has warm clothing and a raincoat as we will be outside all day and the weather may be unpredictable. The children are requested **not** to bring money as we will not be visiting the gift shop.

We request a voluntary contribution for the trip. The guidance for contribution for this visit is **£16.50 per pupil**. We are dependent on the voluntary contributions for the visit to go ahead and ask parents to help with this. However, it is important to point out that, we may have no choice but to cancel the visit if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel and fees.
