<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pass and receive a ball safely using chest and bounce pass technique</li> <li>- Ball awareness – moving ball around different parts of the body</li> <li>- Dribbling and bouncing a ball in a variety of ways</li> <li>- Scoring in a targeted area</li> <li>- Marking a player</li> <li>- Shooting the ball high and bending knees</li> <li>- Protecting the ball in an adapted game</li> <li>- Introduce small sided games</li> <li>- Introduce some key rules to the sport</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ball awareness – copying a partner and moving with the ball</li> <li>- Dribbling the ball in various directions</li> <li>- Pass, receive and most with the ball</li> <li>- Learn the 'BEEF' technique when shooting in isolation</li> <li>- Dribble the ball and perform the correct footwork when stopping</li> <li>- Develop defending techniques and begin to use body to protect the ball</li> <li>- Begin to use techniques learnt within a game situation</li> <li>- Have an understanding of key rules</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Perform a variety of passes within a game with precision and control</li> <li>- Perform correct footwork in a game</li> <li>- Perform a variety of dodges to move into a space and receive a ball, both in practice and games situations</li> <li>- Defend a player during a game and intercept the ball successfully</li> <li>- Shoot into a goal and attempt to rebound if missed</li> <li>- Rotate into different positions on the court</li> <li>- Use defensive techniques in a competitive game situation</li> <li>- Children to officiate and to understand the key rules of the game</li> </ul>
