



Year 5 Curriculum Coverage Overview

Unit:	Overview:
Unit 1: Bon appétit, bonne santé! - Healthy Eating	This unit allows children to revise and extend language about healthy and unhealthy eating and look again at school lunch times in France. It supports developing understanding of masculine, feminine and plural forms of adjectives following the noun and the use of 'au' in place of 'à le'.
Unit 2: Je suis le musician – I am the music man	This unit offers the opportunity to discuss musical tastes, talk about musical instruments that they may play and combine French and Music by looking again at some French composers. It exposes the children to the use of 'du' (m.,) and 'de la' (f.) and revises creating negative statements using 'ne/n'...pas'.
Unit 3: En route pour l'école – On the way to school	The purpose of the unit is to teach simple directions and familiar landmarks in a town. The French alphabet is learned, with opportunity to recognise similarities and differences in pronunciation, and also telling the time to the half hour.
Unit 4: Scène de plage – Beach Scene	This unit allows children to revise colour adjectives while learning new nouns and verbs. There is an opportunity for a cultural cross-curricular link to Art, to use a dictionary to extend vocabulary and verbally extend sentences from starters. It includes further phonic work on soft and hard 'g' sounds.
Unit 5: Le retour de printemps – The return of spring	This unit facilitates revision and further application of familiar vocabulary linked to months, weather and colours. It allows opportunity for extending sentences with new conjunctions and for awareness of grammatical differences in the use, or absence of, capital letters.
Unit 6: Les Planètes – The planets	This unit focuses on developing children's awareness of sentence structure, revising the position of adjectives and adjective agreement and the use of 'il' or 'elle'.
