### **CLUBS SPRING – 2025 – 2026**

Dear Parents and Carers,

**You will need to use your Arbor Account to sign-up for all school-run clubs. Please read through all the information below prior to making a booking.**

There will be a nominal fee of **£20 per term** to pay to secure your child's place on their chosen club.\* This is to support our running and site costs. **Only children who are signed up and paid for will be able to attend their club.** Children who arrive for a club, are not the register and who have not paid, will need to be collected. *\*No charge for children in receipt of Pupil Premium.*

**Bookings will open up on Monday 15 December at 19:00.** To make a booking, login to your Arbor account and go to Activities and Clubs. **TOP TIP** – *If you are booking for more than one child, it is preferable to log onto the Parent Portal (via a website browser, on any device) rather than using the App.*

If a club is full, you **will not** receive a message telling you that is full, it will just re-route you back to the Registration page. You will know that you have successfully booked the place when you get to the Consent screen and provide consent.

Please be advised that after school clubs are not intended to be used as childcare. We cannot guarantee that the club will run every week, and they may need to be cancelled at short notice for unforeseen circumstances. Although we do try our utmost to cover the club with another teacher or move it to another day, sometimes this may not be possible.

If your child is **not attending an after-school club for any reason**, please ensure you notify the school office **in the morning, before midday.**

We can have **over 130 children** attending clubs on some afternoons, and time spent searching for children who have unexpectedly not arrived is considerable. More importantly, it increases our concern that there may be a **genuinely missing child.**

Clubs will start again from **Monday 5 January 2026**, unless otherwise stated below. All after school clubs will continue to run from 3:10pm – 4:00pm. Please collect your child promptly at 4:00pm from the relevant Key Stage gate or playground. Please note: certain clubs will require your child to come into school dressed in their P.E. kit for the whole day, indicated below with **(P.E. KIT)**.
