Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to be taking Reception children on an exciting trip to the Bournemouth Aviation Museum where they will enrich their understanding of our topic on transport. The children will enjoy looking at different types of flying vehicles and how transport has changed.

Travelling by coach, both Reception classes will visit on **Thursday 26 March 2026**. The children will need to wear full school uniform including school shoes.

Please provide your child with a named packed lunchbox and at least two named drinks (no cans or glass bottles), in a suitable backpack. If you have already ordered a hot lunch for your child, then your order will automatically be converted to a packed sandwich lunch. However, if you wish to provide your own packed lunch for this trip, **please make sure you cancel your hot meal order for that day with the school office by Tuesday 17 March 2026 at the latest.** The school frequently incurs losses by preparing lunchboxes, which are not taken up on trips.

For this trip, we request a voluntary contribution of a minimum of **£14.00 payable through Arbor by Friday 13 March 2026**. We are dependent on the voluntary contributions for the visit to go ahead and ask parents to help with this. We will have no choice but to cancel the visit if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel and fees.
