Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to be taking Reception children to an exciting trip to the Farmer Palmers, where they will enrich their understanding of our topic on farm life. The children will enjoy learning about life on a farm and will experience feeding and handling the animals that live there. They will also experience a tractor ride with their teachers and peers.

Travelling by coach, both classes will visit Farmer Palmers on Friday 22 May. The children will need to wear school P.E. kit and sensible footwear. We would advise you to provide a hat for your child, and apply sun cream if the weather is warm, and pack a lightweight waterproof in case it rains.

Please provide your child with a named packed lunchbox and at least two named drinks (no cans or glass bottles), in a suitable backpack. If you have already ordered a hot lunch for your child, then your order will automatically be converted to a packed sandwich lunch. However, if you wish to provide your own packed lunch for this trip, **please make sure you cancel your hot meal order for that day with the school office by Tuesday 12 May at the latest.** The school frequently incurs losses by preparing lunchboxes, which are not taken up on trips and we will have to unfortunately charge for meals prepared by school, but not then taken up.

For this trip, we request a voluntary contribution of a minimum of **£19.00 payable through Arbor by Friday 8 May**. We are dependent on the voluntary contributions for the visit to go ahead and ask parents to help with this. This will include a fun go on the tractor trailer ride. We will have no choice but to cancel the visit if we do not receive enough contributions to cover the cost of travel and fees.
